

NMAT 2023 Exam Notification

NMAT (NMIMS Aptitude Test) is a national-level MBA Entrance test that gives admission to the flagship MBA / PGDM programs of NMIMS Mumbai, Hyderabad, Bangalore, Navi Mumbai and Indore. NMAT is a computer-adaptive test i.e the level of difficulty of the exam is not constant and will be modified as per the responses of the candidate attempting it.

Candidates can attempt the NMAT exam conducted by GMAC up to 3 times i.e one attempt and 2 retakes. The retake attempts are allowed with a gap of 15 days each. In addition to this, the students also have the facility to reschedule the date and time according to their convenience within the 70-75 day test window.

Please note that exam slots at both test centres and online are limited and are available on first-come-first-served basis only. In addition, the exam delivered online will only be available on certain dates with limited capacity within the testing period. We recommend that you schedule your exam.

The NMAT by GMAC™ exam registration and the school application process are two separate steps. We encourage you to frequently review university/b-school program eligibility criteria and the admission process to ensure you are fully informed of requirements and any changes regarding the acceptance of the NMAT by GMAC scores.

Test Fees-

- Test Registration: INR 2800 + applicable taxes
- Retake: INR 2800 + applicable taxes
- Additional Score Reports (beyond first five): INR 300 per Score Report + applicable taxes
- Reschedule: INR 1200 + applicable taxes

NMAT Exam Pattern-

The NMAT exam is a computer-adaptive exam that comprises three sections. The time allotted for the exam is 120 minutes with each section having separate time limits. Given below is the breakup of the sections-

Section	No of Questions	Sectional Time Limit	Range of Marks

- All the questions are multiple-choice questions.
- There is no negative marking for wrong answers. Candidates can attempt a maximum number of questions without worrying about penalties.
- Candidates can choose the order of sections. But once chosen the order cannot be changed.
- A section once closed cannot be reviewed again by the candidates.
- The candidates must attempt all the questions of each section in the allotted sectional time.

NMAT Registration Process-

Level 1	Visiting the official NMAT website and creating an account using a valid email ID and other personal credentials.
Level 2	Open your email account and click on the verification link received by GMAC and sign up successfully for NMAT 2023.
Level 3	Enter your personal credentials, academic credentials, work experience details, choice of MBA courses of various colleges accepting NMAT scores (You can select up to five courses and b-schools), preference of test cities and ID number i.e Aadhaar, PAN, Driving License, etc.
Level 4	Scan and upload your photograph and digital signature as per the resolution (Max 1 MB) and the format (JPG/JPEG, PNG, GIF) specified by GMAC. If the document will be more than the specified format, GMAC would not allow its upload.
Level 5	Save and submit all the above-entered information and proceed to payment. After remitting the fees, you would get your "NMAT ID" which will be provided by GMAC itself. Take a printout for future reference. Now, you will be notified by GMAT for scheduling your exam, booking your slot and downloading your hall ticket. The same will be reflected on your NMAT dashboard.

NMAT 2022 Registration: Key points to remember

- There is no specific age limit to register for NMAT registration dates are extensible and will be governed by GMAC, the test administrator.
- In case there is a delay in registration, you can be sure that admit cards will be available on time.
- The cut-offs and shortlisting process of NMIMS and other colleges accepting NMAT scores will begin after the results will be tentatively declared in January 2024.

How to Schedule NMAT-

- Login to the NMAT account and visit the NMAT Dashboard
- Go to the 'Schedule Exam' option that will be visible after successfully paying the exam fee.
- Schedule the NMAT date and time using the activated feature
- Choose the test mode i.e. either test center-based online test or remote proctored online test from home
- Download the test hall ticket from the dashboard.

NMAT Retake and Reschedule-

Candidates get the option to reschedule their NMAT exam, though a fee must be paid for the same. In NMAT 2023, a candidate was allowed 2 retakes i.e. 3 attempts could be made in NMAT.

How to Retake NMAT-

Candidates have an opportunity to retake the test twice after the first attempt. The option of retaking the test would be activated on the student dashboard after appearing for NMAT once. Retake fees must be paid per attempt by the candidates.

How to Reschedule NMAT-

NMAT candidates have the feasibility of rescheduling their NMAT examination under some urgent circumstances. However, a fee must be paid for the same. If candidates are unable to follow that schedule, it can be very well postponed to a later-on date. Once the exam date is rescheduled, it cannot be set to the former exam date again.

NMAT Admit Card-

NMAT hall tickets will go live on the student dashboard within 24 hours of NMAT registration. Candidates can visit the NMAT dashboard via the official website, nmat.org.in. NMAT 2023 hall tickets can be downloaded online from the NMAT dashboard. The NMAT exam window will tentatively last from October 2023 to December 2023. Candidates must

carry this hall ticket along with a govt. ID proof on the exam day. Here are the details which will be mentioned on the NMAT 2023 hall tickets.

NMAT Cut off-

The cut-off will be the minimum marks candidates will have to score to qualify for admissions. The NMAT cut-off will be released for each MBA specialization after the declaration of the NMAT result. Each participating institute will release a different cut-off. Candidates will be able to check cut-off marks for each section. Candidates who reach the cut-off will get selected for the further admission procedure and have to clear all the shortlisting rounds like Group Discussion (GD), PI (Personal Interview) and WAT (Writing Test Ability) of the participating institute.
